

CNY Reads Announces its 2009/2010 selection

This Pulitzer Prize winning and internationally bestselling novel is an account of the Civil War told from the point of view of Captain March, father of the well known *Little Women* in Louisa May Alcott's famous classic of the same title.

CNY Reads promotes reading, research, discovery, and a sharing of perspectives among Central New Yorkers by encouraging them to read the same book and participate in programs related to the content and themes of that book. *March* was selected in conjunction with Syracuse Opera's May production of *Little Women*, and Syracuse Stage's musical production which runs from November 24 through December 27. Author, Geraldine Brooks, is speaking in Friends of the Central Library's Rosamond Gifford Lecture series on November 10.
