The OCPL Community Quest is open to all CNY residents. The contest begins on Monday, March 15 and ends on Saturday, April 17 at 5:00 pm. The prize drawing will be held Wednesday, April 21 at the Central Library.

Bookmark entry forms are available at all OCPL Libraries. Participating “questers” should look for clues at library service points such as the Reference Desk, Circulation Desk, or Information Desk at any of the OCPL Libraries. Clues will not be hidden in the stacks. Clues may be found in library publications (newsletters) or on websites. Patrons need not check out books to obtain clues.

Only one entry form per person and only forms with all three correct answers will be included in the prize drawing. Entry forms must be submitted to any OCPL Library by closing time on Saturday, April 17. All entries with correct answers (Character, well-known Book, and Library) will be entered in a drawing to be held on Wednesday, April 21. Winners will be drawn at random. Winners will be notified no later than Friday, April 23.
