Wednesdays, November 4, 18 and 25, at 10 a.m.

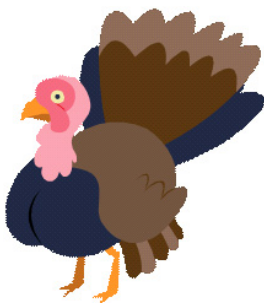
Picture books, songs, and finger rhymes for two year olds and their families to smile over.
