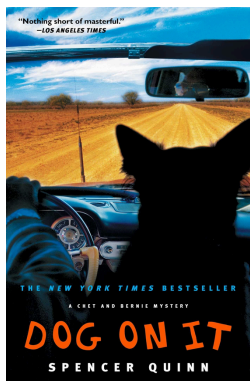

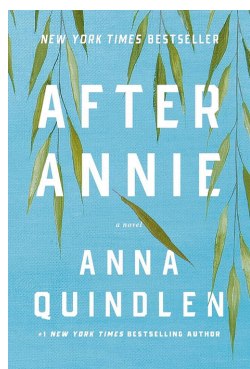


Unraveling Yarns Mystery Book Club

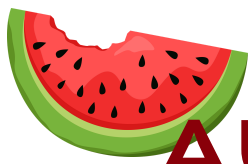

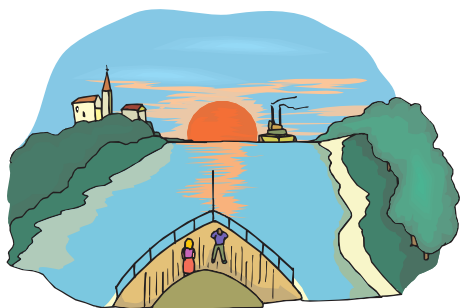

Look for Maxwell Library's table as we help celebrate the legacy of the Erie Canal with the wonderful folks at Camillus Erie Canal Park!

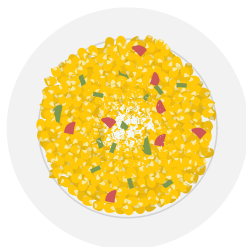
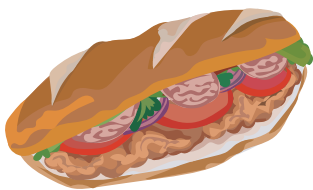


Vegan BBQ with Syracuse Vegan Living Program

Registration required. Ages 18 & up.

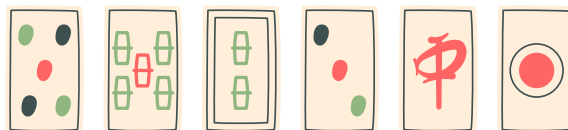


Tech Help Tuesdays

No registration necessary.

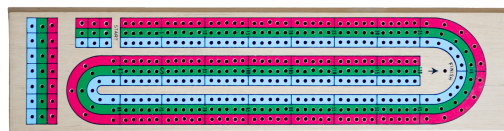


Cribbage & More

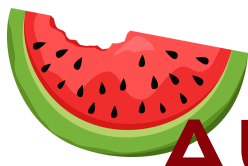
