Outreach (Maggie Foster)


- Outreach for OCPL this month included attending a Resource Fair for ARC of Onondaga Families, a combination meeting for two workgroups – Outreach and Adult Services – and hosting the final program of the CNYArts-funded Haudenosaunee Singers and Dancers.
- The ARC Resource Fair was an excellent opportunity to introduce Passive Post-It Notes for engagement (see attached image). The goal of the notes is to collect feedback from our community members which we can use to develop future initiatives and share with the workgroups. Our question for the resource fair was "What do you want to have at your library?" The answers included the following:
- Reading circles Mental Health Conversation Groups More daytime programs -Storytime for Adults with Disabilities and kids with special needs – study and informational groups - yoga
- The Combination Outreach/Adult Services Meeting was very well attended by OCPL staff, online and in-person at NOPL, Cicero. We had a guest speaker, Amanda Roberts,

- from Onon Cty Office of Aging and Long-Term Care. She was able to highlight the various programs available for our senior community members and those who require long-term care services. The combo meeting included introductions from all the new staff at various locations and the Member Services-Communications staff gave updates for future events/programs.
- The final program of the CNYArts-funded series was hosted by Central Library and featured the Haudenosaunee Singers & Dancers. In addition to traditional dances, the program also offered participants a chance to win handmade items created by Haudenosaunee Artisans and homemade hot scoons (fry bread) with strawberry drink. The door prizes and refreshments were co-sponsored by our community partners at Syracuse Peace Council and Friends of the Central Library. Also on display were suggested reading from Neighbors of the Onondaga Nation, which included items in our Local History/Genealogy Department on the third floor.
