Join us to improve your knitting and crochet skills or learn the basics. Yarn and needles are available, but feel free to bring your own. All ages and skill levels welcome!

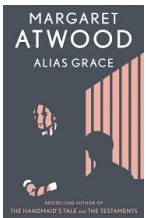
Mayor Sharon Owens
